Position Purpose: This position is responsible for providing technical assistance to the Performance and Evaluation team, Data Analytics team, and external partners in the collection and processing of data.

Responsibilities:

- Responsible for the management and organization of large data sets related to JWB funded programs and initiatives; implements cleaning, organizing and processing of the data
- Implements and maintains libraries related to data, reports, and presentations
- Performs data analysis and prepares tables, charts, reports, and graphs for presentations or reports
- Works closely with program evaluation team in the monitoring of JWB funded programs and initiatives including: data quality, data collection, quantitative and qualitative analysis, and reporting
- Assists with creating SQL Views and reports from SQL Server Reporting Services (SSRS) from the Operational Data Store
 and Data Warehouse to make data available to staff for analysis
- Provides technical assistance to JWB providers involving JWB data systems
- Member of the data analytics team and data committee to ensure data integration is standardized, clean and consistent
- Backup to the FSI Service Point Administrator
- Works cooperatively on inter and intra departmental teams to accomplish established team objectives and timeframes
- Other duties as assigned
