\* If a vehicle which will be transporting passengers is owned by the agency or operated by an employee of the agency, then the agency itself must provide the required limit of insurance for the passenger-transporting vehicle. If the agency contracts the transportation service to another company which owns and operates the vehicle, then the agency is required to maintain on file verification of the required limit of insurance from the transportation company. It is understood that Pinellas County School Board, if used as a transportation vendor, maintains a limit of \$1,000,000 in lieu of the above required limits due to their status as a Florida governmental entity and the sovereign immunity protection they are granted given under the Florida Constitution and Section 768.28, Florida Statutes.
