# **Reading Challenge:**

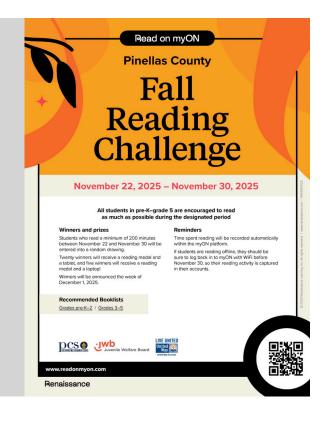
Read as much as possible during the challenge period (11/22 - 11/30)
